Original Condition (El viento trae un estraño lamento), a site specific installation by artist Yanira Collado.

Incorporating various sculptural elements whose presence both forms and informs by the use of semiotic fluidity and collapsing time & space.

Collado creates a repository of transference through the use of reclaimed building materials; paper, textiles, enamels, photography and other ephemera.

She constructs a palimpsest based on an ontological set of principles whose presence is improvisational and infinite.

Yanira Collado is an interdisciplinary artist interested in social dichotomy concepts that allude to entropy and restoration. Collado's work is the intersection of constructivism and vernacular semantics; construction materials, textiles and reclaimed literary texts. Materials with inherent geographic histories, processes and economies that imply varying degrees of private and public memory.

Yanira Collado lives and works in Miami, FL. Collado attended The School of the Art Institute of Chicago. Artist Residency fellowships include the African Heritage Cultural Center, Liberty City, FL 2011-2012 and Bridge Red Art Center 2013-present, North Miami, FL. Yanira Collado was awarded first place in the 2013 South Florida Biennial at the Hollywood Art & Cultural Center, Hollywood, FL. Group shows include Transmissions at The Franklin, Chicago, IL, Dirt at Florida Atlantic University, Boca, Raton, FL, African Presence at Nova University, Fort Lauderdale, FL; 2016, Inscribing: Meditations on time and space at Bridge Red, Miami, FL; 2015, MIA\_BER, Galerie Verein Berliner Künstler, Berlin, Germany, ATL\_MIA at Saltworks Gallery, Atlanta, GA, Third Space: Inventing the possible, MOCA, Miami, FL; 2014, Smoke Signals: Istwa, landscapes y paisajes, South Florida Art Center, Miami, FL, Palimpsests, Carol Jazzar Fine Arts; 2013. In 2015 Collado had her first one person exhibition, "Tibio esta... and always the same" exhibitions at Farside Gallery, non-profit artist space in South Miami and a site specific installation at the prestigious Project Row Houses, Houston, TX as part of the summer visiting A-I-R.
